#6: PHILANTHROPY

01 BEFORE THE MEETING

Officers should arrive at the meeting beforehand to ensure that members have all of the materials needed to complete the following project. Officers should also ask each member to bring two bags of candy to the meeting.



INTRODUCTION 02

This meeting will focus on the fifth YLA pillar: **Philanthropy**. Philanthropy strengthens communities and gives support to good causes. YLA members will learn the importance of philanthropy through the following activity.

03 PRE-EDUCATION

Members can demonstrate philanthropy through donating their time and/or money. This project will include both fundraising and time donated from members. As a chapter, decide what organization you would like to donate to. Members can brainstorm ideas and vote on which organization the Chapter should partner with. Decide what amount you should sell the bags for, and determine a goal of how much money you hope to raise for your organization.



CONCLUSION 04

- Ask each YLA member to bring in two or more bags of individually wrapped candy.
- Set up stations for members to fill candy into bags.
- Market the cause through social media posts, flyers, and announcements.
- Have members volunteer to sell candy bags to students and faculty during lunch periods.
- Students and faculty members can purchase candy bags for themselves or for others.
- Once members have sold the bags, members can distribute the candy bags to each homeroom.
- Donate the earnings to the chosen organization.
