1. Simply Squares— This pattern will make you smile and will be perfect for celebrating the joy of Quilting! Rhonda says it's a stress free pattern and is super fast. It just takes 80 5 inch squares or two charm packs or could make a dent in your scrap box. Rhonda will assist you in having a great time with this one! 2. Swoon Sixteen— Sixteen 16" Blocks, Sixteen Fat Quarters equals One Sweet Quilt. This one is a beauty and will be just perfect to use some bright colors for the Spring season. 3. It's Easy Being Green - The humble nine patch gets a flashy makeover with this fun technique. The blocks in this quilt are made with a popular technique that has at least three names: Disappearing Nine Patch, Magic Nine Patch and Tossed Nine Patch. As you can see Mary used blue instead of green—any color you choose will be wonderful. This is classed as an intermediate pattern. It has it's challenges because of all the triangles you will be working with. It's a fun piece and I love the way it turned out. Quilt size is 60" x 72" Any questions call Mary Smith at 304-478-2899




